

## Training:

Hello Everyone,

### HOW CAN YOU BE PREPARING

If you will be caring there are many things you can be collecting:

Aviaries, towels, nets, possum and kangaroo pouches (call for patterns), small Body Shop type plastic bottles for feeding marsupials, heat bags and start breeding mealworms, cockroaches or crickets, . (for a start!)


### SPONSORS
